



Frequently Asked Questions

1. *What is The Bungalow Club?*

The Bungalow Club is an inspiring, high-design, one-of-a-kind gathering spot for adults who crave conversation, connection, and conviviality!

The Club serves drinks and dinner five nights a week and is open during the weekdays (9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.) as a beautiful, shared workspace.

The building was designed with enticing aesthetics—handsome fabrics, color, inspiring spaces—intended to transport you away from your everyday life while at the Club.

In addition to great food and drink, design and architecture, our programming and events will provide opportunities for flat-out fun, laughter, personal growth, and the ability to meet new and interesting people on a continual basis. Live music—monthly House Concerts, piano in the background, and Sunday Chill in the summer—is an integral part of the cultural fabric at the Club. There will be TED-style talks, guest speakers, film nights, club competitions, food and drink specialists, and “clubs within the club” like kayak, knitting, mah-jongg, bourbon, en plein air painting, and more—all designed to get you thinking, moving, laughing, and connecting!

We strive to deliver a kind of hospitality that is rare and elevated but casual and friendly. We endeavor to offer incredible food and drink created and served by top-notch professionals who take their craft and their passion seriously

2. Where is The Bungalow Club located?

The Bungalow Club is located in the downtown heart of a quaint, historic New England town, Exeter, New Hampshire—One Franklin Street, to be exact. We think of ourselves as “grand country house meets city club.”

The Club sits in the middle of The Porches at Exeter pocket neighborhood with 14 stunning homes surrounding us. Members can walk across the street to the pocket park on the Exeter River with kayak access, wildlife viewings, fishing, and bucolic lounging in Adirondack chairs at the river’s edge.

We are 50 minutes from Boston, 18 minutes to the seacoast beaches, and 19 minutes to Portsmouth.

3. What are the Club hours?

Shared workspace areas are open to members Monday to Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Dinner is served Wednesday through Sunday, 5:00 to 10:00 p.m. The Club will also be open to members on Saturdays and Sundays prior to dinner service provided that Club staff is on-site.

Parties and groups of five or more require reservations with the General Manager.

4. What types of memberships are available at The Bungalow Club?

There are several types of membership, including:

Inaugural Memberships provide full access to all facilities and amenities of the Club to individuals, families, or couples.

Corporate Memberships provide full access to all facilities and amenities of the Club to local companies who use the Club for entertaining and small business meetings. Corporate Members who join during the first year of operations of the Club will be known as *Inaugural Corporate Members*.

Non-Resident Memberships provide full access to all facilities and amenities of the Club to individuals, couples, or families who live more than 50 miles away for a maximum of twelve (12) visits per calendar year.

5. How many memberships are available?

The number is currently limited to 250 memberships. Depending on usage of the Club, this number may increase or decrease.

6. What are the privileges of a membership?

A membership allows the member to use the facilities and amenities at The Bungalow Club and to attend club-sponsored events held at the Club upon payment of the applicable Membership Initiation Fee (MIF), dues, fees, and other charges established by the Club.

7. Will members of my family be permitted to use the membership privileges?

Each Inaugural Membership and National Membership is considered a family membership and will have a primary member and authorized users. Immediate family members of the primary member designated as authorized users are permitted to use the facilities in accordance with the Rules and Regulations established by the Club. A member's immediate family includes the member's spouse/partner living in the member's home and unmarried children who are age 26 and younger. All other family members will be treated as guests of the member.

Corporate Memberships are limited to four employees of the Corporate Member. Family members of authorized employees of Corporate Members are considered guests of the Corporate Member.

Authorized users for each membership will be designated on the membership application.

8. Are guests allowed to use the Club facilities?

It is the intention of The Bungalow Club to accommodate guests without inconvenience to the members in accordance with the Rules and Regulations. Sponsoring members are responsible for all fees and charges incurred by their guests.

Guests are invited to meals at the Club with a member after 5:00 p.m. The shared workspace areas are not open to guests during the day except if the member is having a meeting or eating lunch with the guest.

9. Are children allowed to attend the Club?

Yes! But keep in mind that we are an adult-focused Club. Children under age 14 must be under adult supervision and may not roam the Club. After 7:00 p.m., The Dining Room is reserved for members and guests age 12 and older.

10. What types of fees are associated with membership, and how much are they?

Applicants for membership must pay the applicable one-time, nonrefundable Membership Initiation Fee (MIF) to become members of the Club. Members must also pay monthly dues and meet a quarterly food and beverage spending minimum. The Club establishes the amount of dues, fees, and other charges to be paid by all members from time to time to maintain a high level of service and amenities. Dues are intended to cover all operating costs and debt service.

The fees for each membership type established for the 2019 membership year are outlined below.

Membership Type	Membership Initiation Fee	Monthly Dues	Food & Beverage quarterly minimum
Inaugural	\$3,000	\$150	\$250
Corporate	\$5,000	\$300	\$250
Non-Resident	\$1,500	\$100	\$250

All fees, dues, and charges are subject to change at the discretion of the Club.

11. Are memberships transferable?

No. Members may not transfer or otherwise assign their membership privileges except to the Club. However, memberships may be transferred to an adult child of a member, to a spouse or adult child upon death of a member, or to the ex-spouse of a member upon divorce as provided in the Rules and Regulations of the Club.

12. Can a member transfer their membership to an adult child?

Yes, members may request that the Club transfer their membership to an adult child, who has reached age 26, of the member or spouse upon approval by the Club and the member's spouse, if any. The child must submit an application for membership and pay the required MIF to the Club. The required MIF shall be equal to the difference between the MIF then being charged by the Club and the actual MIF originally paid by the member. Once the membership has been transferred to the child, the original member's privileges will be discontinued.

13. What happens if I choose to resign my membership?

The resigning member is obligated to pay the monthly dues (but not the Food and Beverage minimum) associated with the membership until the end of the membership year, which ends on December 31, in which he or she resigned. The resigning member will be responsible for all dues, fees, and charges incurred prior to the termination of membership privileges. The resigning member will have membership privileges and may continue to use the Club until the end of the membership year as long as all dues, fees, and other charges continue to be paid.

14. What happens upon the death of a member of The Bungalow Club?

In the event of the death of a member, the membership privileges remain with the surviving spouse/ partner. In the event there is no surviving spouse/partner or the surviving spouse/partner does not wish to continue membership, then the membership may be transferred to an adult child (who has reached age 26) of the deceased member upon payment to the Club of the difference between the then-prevailing MIF and the actual MIF paid by the deceased member. Otherwise, the membership shall be deemed resigned.

15. Who is responsible for the operation of The Bungalow Club?

The President of the Club, Kathleen Mahoney, makes all major decisions regarding the Club. She relies on an engaged Board of Advisors to give advice and feedback. The Board of Advisors is appointed by Kathleen Mahoney.
